African countries spend more than \$75 billion to import over 100 million tonnes of cereals a year, despite having a booming agriculture sector. The most consumed grains are maize, rice, and wheat.

World's most produced crops: Wheat, rice, maize, barley, sorghum.

Wheat, rice, and maize account for 41% of the world's caloric intake.

Import dependence on a few crops makes populations vulnerable to shocks.

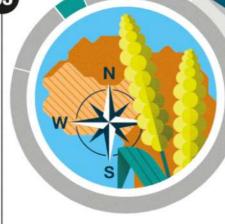

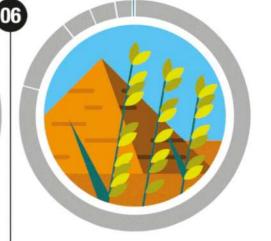
